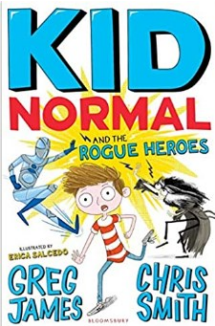

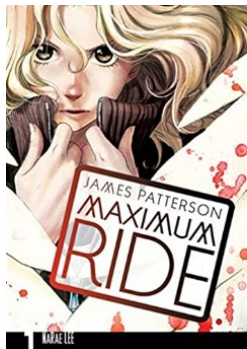


"It was hilarious! It had a nice flow and as it is about superheroes, it was one action scene after another."

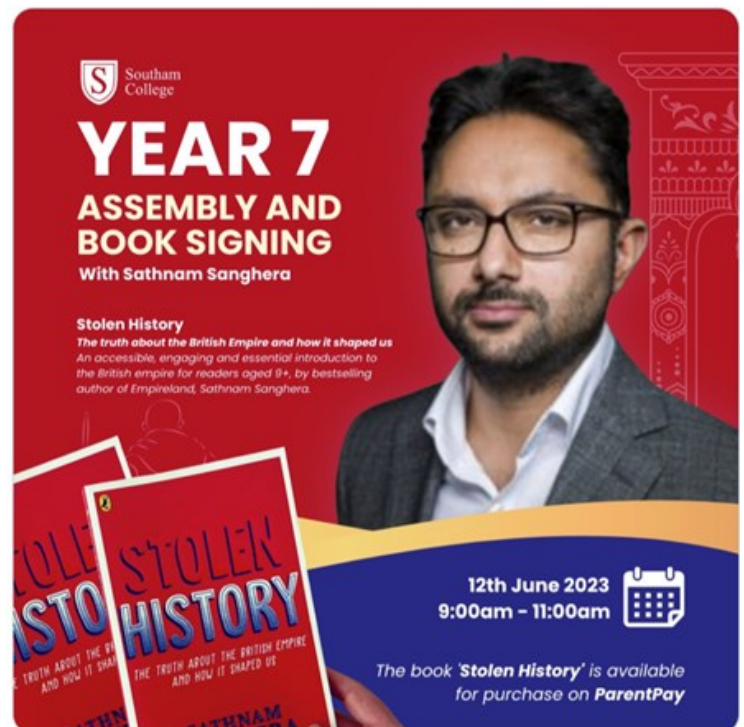
Book of the Month for June
