## Class Learning

NEA Focussed Lessons; Students will be working independently in lessons with the support of their teacher to complete their coursework portfolio. This will be a combination of ICT focussed elements, Designing, Prototyping and manufacturing of their final prototype/product. All students should be making the most of the time and support available during lesson time.

Exam Preparation and Revision; Students will also receive scheduled lessons where the knowledge and content of the course will be delivered and reinforced. Students will be working in their theory books - all information will be used to support and enhance their revision. Remember the exam is split into 3 sections a) Multiple choice across all subjects within D&T, b) Specialist area focused questions, c) Designing and making principles.

#### **Home Learning**

Students should be using Home Learning to supplement and prepare for sections of their NEA. Each student should consider developing draft designs and researching areas directly linked to their product design. This work should be used in the next lesson and incorporated into their NEA folder.

#### Top Tips for External Examination

- Read the guestion carefully, underline key words give the answer that is required.
- Look at how many marks each question is worth, have you written enough?
- Select the question that matches the specific subject you have been working on. E.g. Resistant materials or Textiles.
- Answer with correct terminology state specific materials rather than the category i.e. timber, metal fabrics etc..
- Answer all the questions, even if you have an educated guess—Never leave a question blank.
- Use all of the time you have available. Check your answers are sensible and that you haven't missed a page by mistake.

#### **Top Tips for NEA**

- Use your lesson time wisely.
- Work at pace,
- Stick to deadlines.
- Do additional draft work at home.
- Fill pages with detailed and relevant information.
- Throughout your designing make reference to further research.
- Fully analyse and justify the work you do.
- Ensure that all research pages have some sketching throughout.
- Ensure you drawings incorporate colour and look realistic.
- Use resources on the shared area to support your learning.
