## Entry Criteria

The minimum general requirements for Sixth Form entry are a minimum of 5 GCSE Grade 4 s including English and Maths. In addition to this, individual option routes have subject specific criteria as detailed below.

GCSE Grade 6 or above in Art \& Design and English.

| Art | GCSE Grade 6 or above in Art \& Design and English. |
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| Biology | Separate Science. Students must have a Grade 7 in the Science they wish to study with at least a Grade 6 in the others. Students must have a Grade 6 in Mathematics. <br> Combined Science. Students must have a Grade 7 in Combined Science with at least a Grade 6 in Mathematics. <br> Students who do not meet the above criteria can still be considered subject to a Head Start test in their first lesson in September. |
| Business Studies | If Business has been studied at GCSE, a minimum of a Grade 6 or above. It is not necessary for Business to have been studied at GCSE level for it to be taken at A Level. Students need at least 5 GCSEs at Grade 4 or above including Maths and English at Grade 6 or above. |
| BTEC Business | A Merit at BTEC Business Level 2 if previously studied. Students who have not studied Business before will require 5 GCSEs at Grade 4 including English and Maths. |
| Chemistry | Separate Science. Students must have a Grade 7 in the Science they wish to study with at least a Grade 6 in the others. Students must have a Grade 6 in Mathematics. <br> Combined Science. Students must have a Grade 7 in Combined Science with at least a Grade 6 in Mathematics. <br> Students who do not meet the above criteria can still be considered subject to a Head Start test in their first lesson in September. |
| Computer Science | GCSE Grade 6 in Computer Science or Grade 6 or above in English and Mathematics. |
| Criminology | GCSE Grade 5 or above in English Language or English Literature. |
| Economics | GCSE English and Mathematics at Grade 6 or above. |
| English Language | GCSE Grade 6 or above in English Language. |
| English Literature | GCSE Grade 6 or above in English Literature. |
| Food Science | Grade 5 in GCSE Food Preparation and Nutrition (if studied) and Grade 5 in GCSE Science. Students who have not studied Food at GCSE will be considered if they can prove they have a real passion and commitment to the subject. |
| French | The A Level course is aimed at students who have gained a Grade 7 in GCSE French OR a GCSE Grade 6 and passing the Head Start Grammar Test in September of Year 12. |
| Geography | GCSE Grade 6 or above in Geography and a Grade 6 in English Language or Literature. |
| German | The A Level course is aimed at students who have gained a Grade 7 in GCSE German OR a GCSE Grade 6 and passing the Head Start Grammar Test in September of Year 12. |
| Graphics | GCSE Grade 6 or above in Graphics or Art or Photography; Grade 5 or above in English. |
| BTEC Health and Social Care (Single) | As per the Sixth Form general entry criteria. |
| BTEC Health and Social Care (Double) | As per the Sixth Form general entry criteria. |
| History | GCSE Grade 6 or above in History. |
| Level 3 Cambridge Technical Certificate in IT | As per the Sixth Form general entry criteria. |
| Maths | GCSE Grade 7 or above in Mathematics, having completed the full Higher GCSE course OR GCSE Grade 6 having completed the full Higher GCSE course and $60 \%$ or above in the Head Start assessment. |


| Further Maths | GCSE Grade 7 in Mathematics (higher level) and 75\% or above in the Head Start September assessment. |
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| Media Studies | GCSE Grade 6 in Media Studies or Grade 6 in English Language or English Literature plus a Portfolio of work. Discussion with Head of Department. |
| Music | GCSE grade 6 or above in Music. If you would be interested in BTEC Level 3 Music Performance please speak to Mrs Thompson. |
| Philosophy and Ethics | A GCSE in English Literature or Language at Grade 6 is required and a CCSE Grade 6 in Religious is preferred but not essential. |
| Photography | GCSE Grade 6 or above in Photography; Grade 5 or above in English. |
| Physical Education | GCSE Grade 6 or above in Physical Education with a minimum of a Grade 6 in the written element of the examination. Playing at least one sport on a regular basis at club standard (equivalent) or above. For pupils who did not take PE, the GCSE Science grade and evidence of practical ability would be considered. |
| Physics | Separate Science. Students must have a Grade 7 in the Science they wish to study with at least a Grade 6 in the others. Students must have a Grade 6 in Mathematics. <br> Combined Science. Students must have a Grade 7 in Combined Science with at least a Grade 6 in Mathematics. <br> Students who do not meet the above criteria can still be considered subject to a Head Start test in their first lesson in September. |
| Politics | Grade 5 or above in History GCSE or Grade 6 in English Literature/English Language CCSE. |
| Product Design | GCSE Grade 6 or above in the Design \& Technology options of resistant materials, or graphic products. Students studying Engineering require a Distinction in Engineering and GCSE Grades 5 or above in Mathematics \& Science. |
| Psychology | GCSE Grade 6 or above in English Language or Literature, Mathematics and Grade 6 in Science. |
| BTEC Science | Grade 4 in Combined Science, or Grade 4 in all three separate sciences. |
| Sociology | GCSE Grade 6 or above in English language or English literature. |
| BTEC Sport | Combined/separate Science GCSEs at Grade 4 or above. GCSE PE at Grade 4 or above. Special consideration will be given to those with Level 2 BTEC Sport at Grade Merit or above. Playing at least one sport on a regular basis at club standard or above. |
| Spanish | The A Level course is aimed at students who have gained a Grade 7 in GCSE Spanish OR a GCSE Grade 6 and passing the Head Start Grammar Test in September of Year 12. |
| Textiles | GCSE Grade 6 or above in Design and Technology (Textiles specialism) or Art and Design plus a Grade 5 or above in English. |
